**Quality Improvement Initiatives for patients with ...**

Since inflammatory bowel diseases (IBD) are chronic disorders with typical remission and relapses and no cure, maintaining high quality of provided healthcare to patients with IBD plays a major role in the management and reducing disease-related morbidity. To hone process-based quality indicators in order to ameliorate quality of care, the indicators must be based on high quality evidence and expert consensus.

**Quality improvement in healthcare for patients with ...**

The inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) programme was established over 10 years ago with the aim of improving the quality and safety of care for people with IBD throughout the UK. The initial emphasis was to audit quality and care to show variation, but through four rounds of audit the programme has steadily evolved to encompass a wider range of quality improvement measures.

Finally, explicit process and outcome QIs for adult patients with IBD are important for several reasons 90: [1] to better understand where deficiencies in quality care exist, and thus help direct and prioritize improvement efforts; [2] to establish goals for performance competency in IBD care; [3] to create physician-established measures in anticipation of mandated QI development by third ...

**'Quality of Care' Standards in Inflammatory Bowel Disease ...**

Best care for inflammatory bowel disease patients will involve services provided by a multidisciplinary team, ideally delivered at a centre of excellence and founded on current guidelines. Dedicated telephone support lines, virtual clinics and networking may also provide models through which to deliver high-quality, expert integrated patient care.

**IBD Standards and Benchmarking**

Probiotics, prebiotics and dietary fibre supplements are novel alternative therapies in the treatment of inflammatory bowel disease (IBD). These agents help to alter the microbes in the gut and help offset levels of inflammation. In addition, they are safer and increasingly cost-effective in comparison to pharmaceutical therapies used for IBD.

**Ongoing research projects — IBD Unit**

We sought to improve chronic care delivery and outcomes for children with inflammatory bowel disease by using network-based quality improvement methods. Methods: By using a modified Breakthrough Series collaborative structure, 6 ImproveCareNow Network care centers tested changes in chronic illness care and collected data monthly. We used an interrupted time series design to evaluate the impact of these changes.
