The original manuscripts of Wordsworth's poetry, now held by the Wordsworth Trust in Grasmere, hold not just words, but moments in time: their meanings go beyond the words. The role of the curator is to encourage and facilitate this deeper understanding through the interpretation of Dove Cottage, Town End and the internationally significant collections held in the Jerwood Centre.
